Great Knot (above)

Size: About 28 cm (from the tip of the bill to the tail)

Weight: Around 155 g

IUCN Red List status: Endangered

Red Knot (left)

Size: About 24 cm (from the tip of the bill to the tail)

Weight: Around 100 g

IUCN Red List status: Near Threatened

Red Knots and Great Knots are small, stocky wading birds. They breed in the eastern Russia and spend their non-breeding time in Australia and New Zealand. They use large, muddy estuaries around the coast for feeding. They travel around 21,000 km a year! The population of both species has been declining at a rate of 2-2.5 % per year in recent decades, primarily as a result of habitat loss at the stopover sites. **Conditions:**

Must be aged 6-18 years of age (on August 2017) and living in the East Asian-Australasian Flyway.

The artwork should be your own work. You can use any medium to create your poster but it must be A3 size. If you are from a developing country and cannot find A3 size paper in your school area, size A4 paper is acceptable.

The EAAFP Secretariat may use the artwork in its publications and websites without compensation or approval by the artist but his/her name will be mentioned.
