

## Can you please specify your proposed event plan and expected outcome?

**Purpose:** The Mongolian Ornithological Society has been organizing this event in Mongolia collaborating with Ramsar National Committee, Ministry of Environment and Tourism, Fresh Water and Nature Conservation Centre, National University of Mongolia, State Agriculture University, and many other organization and individuals for last 7 year. From 2011- 2015, the Society sponsored the event in Mongolia.

Propose of our event in Mongolia is to promote the importance of conservation of migratory birds to school children and public through the organizing of special guest lectures, Bird Watching Tour, Mini Bird Race, “Mongolia Migratory Birds Art Competition”, and Migratory Bird Photograph Exhibition in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia.

### **Outcome:**

- Professor and senior scientists will be given lectures on migratory birds with the topic “Their Future is Our Future”, Threats to Migratory Birds, and Birding and Bird Science to 600 school children, University students, and public.
- Bird Watching Tour and Mini Bird Race for 110 school children and University students will be organized by the Society members.
- The contest of the Mongolia Migratory Birds Art will be organized by the Society member and Secondary Schools for more than 300 school children.
- Migratory Bird Photography Contest will be organized by the Society.
