1. Introduction:

The Small Grant for 2018 [World Migratory Bird Day](#) (WMBD) has been established to provide financial support to [EAAFP Partners](#) and collaborators from [EAAFP Task Forces and Working Groups](#) who plan to organize **public events and/or conservation action-oriented workshops** at national or local levels through participating in the World Migratory Bird Day. We strongly encourage EAAFP Partners and collaborators to make an application for any suitable event or development of WMBD materials in local language that aims to raise awareness on the need of conserving migratory waterbirds and the value of their habitats in East Asian – Australasian Flyway.

2. Eligibility Criteria:

EAAFP Partners who plan to organize an event to celebrate 2018 World Migratory Bird Day in the following countries: **Bangladesh, Cambodia, Indonesia, Mongolia, Myanmar, Philippines, Thailand and Viet Nam** are eligible to apply. (If you are not sure, please see [the list of EAAFP Partners](#)).

If you are not the country focal point of EAAFP, please consult and plan with EAAFP focal point of your country before you apply.

Please note that this grant is to initiate a WMBD event, not to cover the costs for the existing WMBD event expenses. Applications with similar contents (location, target participants etc.) from the previous years may not be accepted.

Note:

This form must be filled by an applicant organization only if applicant or applicant organization qualifies the eligibility criteria set for funding assistance under 2018 EAAFP WMBD Small Grants Programme.

For your budget planning, please note that approximately total 1,000 USD will be allocated to each county. The small-scale grant will be allocated on a first come first served basis, we recommend you submit the application as early as possible.

The deadline for application is **18 April 2018**. Please submit an application to Ms. Hyeseon Do, Programme Officer via email (Word or PDF document) at programme@eaaflyway.net and wmbd@eaaflyway.net.

After receipt of your application, the Secretariat will review it and then inform you of the result of your application within one or two weeks. Incomplete applications will not be processed further.

We, UKM HIMPUS - student representation of Veterinary Faculty of Syiah Kuala University, will carry out our second organized event to spread the word about WMBD. In 2015, UKM HIMPUS participated in a WMBD event organized by Aceh Birder. In 2016 - 2017 UKM HIMPUS continued WMBD celebrations as an organizer. So, this year we would like to continue our engagement in WMBD celebrations.

The series of activities that we propose starting in April 30th - May 13th, 2018 as the peak of the celebration, namely:

1. The distribution of sticker about bird's migration to residents around Syiah Kuala University on 30th April 2018.
2. Media event: Photography competition about bird's migration on May 1st 2018. Participation is open for college student.
3. Migratory birds picture coloring contest for kindergarten children on 4th of May 2018 at the Veterinary Faculty Of University Syiah Kuala.
4. Seminar dedicated to the World Migratory Bird Day 2018 theme "Unifying Our Voices for Bird Conservation" on the 13th of May 2018 at the Veterinary Faculty Of University Syiah Kuala. (Presentation by drh. Agus Nurza, M.Si as Expert Birdwather In Sumatera and Rubama. M as Experts in the Field of Conservation).
5. Observation and Birdwatching of Bird Migration on 13th of May 2018 at the Province of Aceh in Ujung Pancu Peukan Bada, Aceh Besar, Indonesia.
6. Beachside cleaning in Ujung Pancu Peukan Bada by all members of UKM HIMPUS and seminar participants after birdwatching.

The target participants are the students of University Syiah Kuala, the students of Universities in Aceh, the student of elementary, and high schools in Aceh and the Public. We expect a total of 350 people, more or less.

We hope this activities will provide early education for the children, increasing the awareness of Aceh's citizens regarding migratory birds, and living in a healthy environments for the migratory birds and humans. In doing so we also hope that it will trigger more activiies for nature preservation especially to preserve the life of birds.
