

The series of activities that we propose starting in May 6th and then May 14th, 2017 as the peak of the celebration, namely:

1. Seminar of the World Migratory Bird Day in theme of A healthy Planets for Migratory Birds and People, "Their Future is Our Future" on the 14th of May 2017 at the Veterinary Faculty Of Syiah Kuala University (Presentation by drh. Agus Nurza M.Si as Expert Birdwatcher In Sumatra, and Dr. Ir. Aida Fithri, M.Sc as Lecturer ornitologies in FMIPA, Syiah Kuala University).
2. Observation and Birdwatching of Bird Migration on 14th of May 2017 at the Province of Aceh in Ujong Pancu Peukan Bada, Aceh Besar, Indonesia.
3. Migratory birds picture coloring contest for kindergarten children equal on 13th of May at the Veterinary Faculty Of Syiah Kuala University.
4. Action to clean up the beach on 14th of May 2017 at the province of Aceh in Ujong Pancu Peukan Bada, Aceh Besar, Indonesia.

The target for the participants are the students of University Syiah Kuala, the students of Universities in Aceh, the student of elementary, and high schools in Aceh and the Public. We expected there will be a total of 350 people; more or less.

We hope this activities will provide early education for the children, increasing the awareness of Aceh's citizen regarding migratory birds, and living in a healthy earth environments for the migratory birds and humans. In doing so we also hope that it will trigger more activiies for nature preservation especially to preserve the life of birds.
