Himpunan Mahasiswa Pecinta Unggas (HIMPUS) has successfully celebrated the World Migratory Bird Day 2021 in Indonesia on 1-2 May 2021 with a series of activities, namely;

1. Webinar World Migratory Bird Day 2021 Indonesia

This webinar will be held on **May 2, 2021**, at: 09.00-12.00 WIB which will be held online through the ZOOM application. This webinar was completed with educational activities related to migratory birds and their habitats by experienced speakers in Indonesia, namely:

1. Hasri Abdillah from Aceh birder and Burung Sumatera
2. Karyadi Baskoro from Ornitologist Diponogoro University

The presenters shared education related to the basic concept of conservation in protecting migratory birds and introduced migratory birds that had been encountered in Indonesian territory from observations that had been made. The topic of discussion shared by Hasri Abdillah was entitled Migratory Water Birds and Habitat. Meanwhile, what Karyadi Baskoro shared were Ecology and Conservation.

This activity was attended by 287 participants from various professional backgrounds such as students, students, researchers, bird watchers and the media. This activity was successful and there were many positive opinions from the webinar participants. At the end of the activity, the minister also gave participants the opportunity to discuss and some lucky participants the committee gave a door prize in the form of a WMBD 2021 shirt.

The schedule of this Webinar activity was changed from the previous plan due to a few obstacles so that the implementation was moved forward 1 day from the initial planning. The rest of the activities run successfully as expected.

2. Field trip, Birdwatching and cleaning trash

This activity will be held on May 1, 2021 at 15.00-18.00 WIB in Ujong Pancu area, Banda Aceh, Indonesia. This activity was attended by 25 people who were stationed in Indonesia who were still in the COVID-19 pandemic situation so that the limitation on the number of participants was like that. However, this activity also applies existing health protocols.

Birdwatching is carried out in the Ujong Pancu coastal area, Banda Aceh as this area is used as a place to observe the migration water failure which is often carried out by local observers. In this activity, no large groups of migratory birds were found but still found permanent migratory birds and some local waterbirds. This can still be used as education for participants who take part in this activity by seeing first-hand the conditions of migratory bird habitat in Aceh, Indonesia.

The participants were very enthusiastic in participating in this activity using the tools provided by the committee. In addition, the participants carried out beachside cleaning activities with the aim of reducing disturbance to habitat damage from the pollution of your plastic waste. So as to foster a higher sense of environmental love awareness with this activity.


