
The event 'Roadshow Celebrating the WMBD by strengthening public awareness through Tourism Community' was held by Aceh Birder on October, 14-15^h 2023 both in Lhokseumawe District and Takengon district of Aceh Province, Indonesia.

1. Day 1. Roadshow WMBD, Depik inn of Takengon, October 14th 2023

The Aceh Birder gave a presentation to the participant and also display of the Migratory Birds movie. Drh Agus Nurza Z, M.Si, the founder of Aceh Birder talked about the history of ornithology in Aceh province and the recent migratory bird report. He share their experience in studying migrating birds and birding tourism efforts in Aceh with Aceh Birder and Remote Sumatra Tour.



The participants have the opportunity to watch the birds on its habitat. Indrayani from Remote Sumatra share a tips and resources for learning to identify birds, using bird watching equipment, and an introduction to birding. The participant also learned on how to use a binoculars and spotting scope to do birdwatching.



Birdwatching activities took place in the Roofdeck Depik inn and the rice field of the Lut tawar Lake during in the afternoon. About 25 participant both of the tourism ambassador and tourism community participated in this event.



During the activity, no large groups of migratory birds were found but still found permanent migratory birds and some resident waterbirds. This can still be used as education for participants who took part in this activity by seeing first-hand the conditions of migratory bird habitat in Lut Tawar Lake of Takengon, Aceh Tengah of Aceh province, Indonesia. The participants were very enthusiastic in participating in this activity using the tools provided by the committee. The crew also prepared doorprize for the participants as rewards and each participant also received a souvenir. Then Closing the event and the Team of Roadshow WMBD transfer to Lhokseumawe district.





2. Day 2. Roadshow WMBD, Malikussaleh University of Lhokseumawe, October 15th 2023


The second day we arrive in Lhokseumawe district. This activity was carried out on October 15th 2023 from 09.00-12.30 WIB in UKM UMPAL of Malikussaleh University of Lhokseumawe and from 14.00-17.30 WIB in Waduk Pusong. The first program of the event was a presentation about migratory birds and WMBD by Drh Agus Nurza Z, M.Si. The presentation introducing several types of migratory birds in Aceh Province using audio video media from a projector. He share their experience in studying migrating birds and birding tourism efforts in Aceh with Aceh Birder and Remote Sumatra Tour. The second discussion session explained small activities that could save the earth in the future was filled by Indrayani, head of Remote Sumatra.



The participant of the event are both of the tourism ambassador and tourism community and from Student Activity Unit (UKM) of Malikussaleh University like UKM UMPAL, UKM Taekwondo, UKM Creative Minority, UKM LDK AI – Kautsar, UKM Seni Budaya, UKM Pramuka, UKM Sain, Riset, Robotika (SRR), UKM PMI/KSR, UKM Turtle Diving Club (TDC) and UKM PA JIPALA from Institut Agama Islam Negeri (IAIN) Lhokseumawe. About 69 participants took part in seminar and there are doorprize for the participants as rewards and also received a souvenir.



The last activity of the series was field observations which were carried out in Waduk Pusong Kota Lhokseumawe. Waduk Pusong is a birding hotspot located in Lhokseumawe city, which comprises wetlands such as lakes, river basins, and mudflats. Its area serves as an important resting and feeding habitat for migratory birds, especially threatened species such as Far Eastern Curlew (*Numenius madagascariensis*).



Indrayani from Remote Sumatra share a tips and resources for learning to identify birds, using bird watching equipment, and an introduction to birding. The participant also learned on how to use a binoculars and spotting scope to do birdwatching. Learning to use binoculars is a key naturalist skill and makes life as a beginning birder

that much easier. About 29 participants took part in birdwatching field trip activities to celebrate World Migratory Bird Day 2023 in Lhokseumawe.



The participants were very enthusiastic to watch birds. Participants have showed live streaming during the activity and make short videos or photo activity and share on their personal accounts social media such as FaceBook, Instagram, TikTok and others. In addition to bird watching, the participants also learned bird watching techniques from speakers who are experts in their fields. The observations were made to coincide with the migratory season, when the migratory birds are already heading to their feeding in mudflat area. From the field trip, participants could see Far Eastern Curlew, Common Sandpiper, Terek Sandpiper, Golden Plover and Lesser Sand plover, etc.



As a result of the event, all participants to raise awareness and improve understanding on migratory birds and the importance of their habitats. Public awareness of conserving migratory birds and wetlands will increase. They will be able to identify the migratory birds at Aceh Province area and increase their interest and self-motivated to further conservation activities on migratory birds. Especially, as they acknowledged the nearby place such as Waduk Pusong Lhokseumawe, we believe it would lead the participants to have further engagement too.
