GENERAL INFORMATION

Hosted by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) of the Philippines in collaboration with the Secretariat of the East Asian–Australasian Flyway Partnership (EAAFP), the 12th Meeting of Partners (MOP12) is set to take place from 8 to 14 November 2025 in Cebu, Philippines.

This biennial event serves as a vital platform for our Partners to come together to review progress towards the Strategic Plan, chart the Partnership's future direction, and strengthen our shared mission. It also offers a unique opportunity for Flyway Site Managers, Working Groups, and Task Forces to exchange experiences, forge new collaborations, and strategise actions.

With the theme "Weaving Connections: Celebrating Migration, Traditional Knowledge, and Innovation across our Flyway," the gathering embodies the spirit of uniting diverse communities, fostering scientific innovation, and honouring shared traditional knowledge across the Flyway.

VISA INFORMATION

As of the latest guidelines from the Philippine Bureau of Immigration and the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA), nationals from most countries may enter the Philippines without a visa for tourism or business purposes for a stay of up to 30 days, provided they have:

- A passport valid for at least six (6) months beyond their intended stay, and
- A return or onward ticket.

Citizens from countries not covered by the visa exemption policy must secure a visa prior to entering the Philippines, regardless of the purpose or duration of stay.

All foreign participants attending MOP12 in the Philippines are required to comply with the applicable Philippine visa regulations. Participants attending for official or conference-related purposes may apply for a 9(a) Temporary Visitor Visa, selecting "Business/Conference" as the purpose of travel.

TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

Airport

The Mactan-Cebu International Airport (MCIA) serves as the primary gateway to the venue. The airport is approximately 20 minutes by car from Shangri-La Mactan, Cebu.

Flights

It is recommended to check for direct flights to Mactan-Cebu International Airport (MCIA) for your convenience. If direct flights to MCIA are not available from your location, you may consider flying into Ninoy Aquino International Airport (MNL) in Manila, where connecting flights to Cebu are frequent and readily available.

Arrival and Departure Requirements

Visitors arriving in and departing from the Philippines are required to register on eTravel, a web-based platform for immigration, health surveillance, and customs. Registration can be done within 72 hours prior to the travel date. To access, visit https://etravel.gov.ph/ or download the eGovPH app from App Store or Google Play.

Transportation Options in Cebu

- **Airport Taxi or Ride-Hailing Applications**: Approximate fare to Shangri-La Mactan ranges from PHP 400 to 600 or USD 7 to 11.
- **Hotel Airport Shuttle:** Contact Shangri-La Mactan or your booked hotel directly for shuttle service availability and pricing.

When using a taxi, kindly ensure the driver uses the meter or agrees on the fare in advance to avoid overcharging.

For safety reasons, it is recommended to book a taxi or car rather than a motorcycle for your transportation.



FIELD TRIP

OLANGO ISLAND WILDLIFE SANCTUARY [EAAF007]

Olango Island Wildlife Sanctuary (OIWS) [EAAF007], the Philippines' first Flyway Network Site, is a low-lying island surrounded by extensive intertidal sandflats, mangroves, seagrass beds, coral reefs, and islets. Recognised for its ecological importance, it is one of the ten Ramsar sites in the Philippines designated as Wetlands of International Importance under the Convention on Wetlands.



For your comfort and safety during the field trip to OIWS, it is recommended to wear appropriate clothing that provides protection from both the sun and rain. Comfortable, lightweight, and quick-drying clothes are ideal.




Rubber-soled footwear is strongly recommended as it provides better grip on potentially uneven or slippery boardwalks and helps minimise noise while walking along the paths.



Please remember to bring hats or umbrellas for additional sun and rain protection.

LANGUAGE

The official language of MOP12 will be **English**.

DOCUMENTS

Participants are kindly reminded to bring their own copies of the pre-session workshop

documents, as no additional hard copies will be provided on site. Printer access will be limited,

so the use of electronic copies is encouraged. All documents will be available for download on

the dedicated MOP12 meeting webpage.

DRESS CODE

Participants are expected to wear business casual attire throughout the event. For the welcome

reception, participants are encouraged to wear cultural or traditional attire representing their

country or region.

WEATHER AND TIME ZONE

Cebu has a tropical climate, characterised by warm and humid conditions throughout the year.

In November, participants can expect average temperatures between 25-30°C. While it is

generally the tail end of the rainy season, occasional rain showers may still occur, so participants

are advised to bring light rain gear or an umbrella.

COVID-19

The Philippines no longer requires proof of COVID-19 vaccination, testing, or quarantine for inbound travellers. All passengers are admitted regardless of vaccination status.

Yellow Fever & Other Vaccines

No special vaccinations are required for general entry. Yellow fever vaccination is only mandatory if you are arriving from a yellow fever-endemic country

Shangri-La Mactan provides an on-call doctor for guests. Nearby medical facilities include the following:



Sun & Heat Safety

Participants are advised to take sun protection measures by wearing sunglasses, applying sunscreen with SPF 30 or higher, and staying well-hydrated.

ELECTRICITY

The standard electrical voltage in the Philippines is 220V, with a frequency of 60Hz. Power plugs used are typically Type A, Type B, and Type C, though Type A (two flat parallel pins) is the most commonly used. Participants from countries using different plug types are advised to bring a suitable power plug adapter.



CURRENCY

Currency

The official currency of the Philippines is the Philippine Peso (PHP). As of May 13, 2025, the exchange rate is approximately:

1 USD = 55.73 PHP

Please note that exchange rates may fluctuate.

Currency Exchange and ATMs

Currency exchange services are available at major airports, hotels, banks, and malls throughout Cebu.

ATMs are widely accessible and accept major international cards, including Visa, MasterCard, Cirrus, and Maestro.

Credit cards such as American Express, MasterCard, Visa, and JCB are commonly accepted in hotels, restaurants, and larger retail establishments.

However, it is advisable to carry some local currency (Philippine Peso) for small purchases, transportation, and locations where card payments may not be accepted.

BUSINESS HOURS

Most establishments are open daily from 9:00 AM to 10:00 PM. Convenience stores and some restaurants operate 24/7.

SAFETY AND EMERGENCY

Cebu is generally considered a safe destination for travellers. For emergencies, dial 911 for police, fire, or ambulance services.
