#### **Background**

Conservation of migratory land birds has long been neglected in Asia but recent studies showed many species of migratory land birds are declining at alarming rates (such as the Yellow-breasted Bunting). A monitoring scheme of land birds has been established in North East Asian countries (Russia, China, RO Korea and Japan) since 2015 and there is a need to extend the cooperation to wintering countries in the EAAF. After discussion with partners in the EAAF, the Wild Bird Society of Japan submitted a decision paper on establishing an ad hoc committee to discuss the inclusion of land birds to the scope of the EAAFP for the decision in MOP 13. This site-event is for improving understanding on issues related to land birds amongst partners of the EAAFP.

#### **Objectives**

The purpose of this meeting is to reach a consensus among countries along the EAAF on the process of developing a platform on conservation and monitoring of migratory land birds along the EAAF.

**Expected Outcomes** The output will be a report on recommendations of an ad hoc committee on land bird monitoring and conservation in EAAF countries.
